Surgery has many sub-specialties: General Surgery, Transplant Surgery, Trauma Surgery, Cardiovascular Surgery, Neurosurgery, Maxillofacial Surgery, Orthopedic Surgery, Otolaryngology, Plastic Surgery, Oncologic Surgery, Vascular Surgery and Pediatric Surgery.


Medicine:

- Internal Medicine: The medical speciality concerned with the diagnosis, management and non surgical treatment of unusual or serious diseases, either of one particular organ system or of the body as a whole.
- Sub-specialities of Internal Medicine: Cardiology, Critical care medicine, Dermatology, Emergency medicine, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, Geriatrics, Haematology, hepatology, Infectious diseases, Nephrology, Neurology, Oncology, Pediatrics, Pulmonology, Rheumatology, Sleep medicine.

Diagnostic Specialties:

- Clinical Laboratory: It is applied on laboratory techniques for diagnosis and management of patients. Sub-specialties include Transfusion medicine, Cellular pathology, Clinical Chemistry, Hematology, Clinical microbiology and Clinical immunology.
- Pathology: It is the Branch of Medicine that deals with the study of diseases and the morphological, physiological changes produced by them.
- Radiology: It is the Branch of Medicine which is concerned with imaging of the human body, e.g.x-rays, x-ray computed tomography, ultrasonography, and nuclear magnetic resonance tomography.
- Nuclear Medicine: It is the Branch of Medicine which is concerned with studying of human organ systems by administering radiolabelled substances (radiopharmaceuticals) to the body, which can then be imaged outside the body by a gamma camera or a PET scanner.
- Clinical neurophysiology: It is the Branch of Medicine with testing the
 physiology of function of the central and peripheral aspects of the nervous
 system. Sub-specialties include Electroencephalography, Electromyography,
 Evoked potential, Nerve conduction study and Polysomnography.

- Other Fields of Medical Speciality: Following are some selected fields of medical specialties that do not directly fit into any of the above mentioned groups.
- Ophthalmology exclusively concerned with the eye and ocular adnexa, combining conservative and surgical therapy.
- Dermatology is concerned with the skin and its diseases. In UK, dermatology is a subspecialty of general medicine.
- Emergency medicine is concerned with the diagnosis and treatment of acute or life-threatening conditions, including trauma, surgical, medical, pediatric, and psychiatric emergencies.
- Obstetrics and gynaecology (often abbreviated as OB/GYN (American English) or Obs and Gynae (British English) and concerned respectively with childbirth and the female reproductive and associated organs. Reproductive medicine and fertility medicine are generally practiced by gynecological specialists.
- Palliative care is a relatively modern branch of clinical medicine that deals with pain and symptom relief and emotional support in patients with terminal illnesses including cancer and heart failure.
- Pediatrics (AE) or paediatrics (BE) is devoted to the care of infants, children, and adolescents. Like internal medicine, there are many pediatric subspecialties for specific age ranges, organ systems, disease classes, and sites of care delivery.
- Physical medicine and rehabilitation (or physiatry) is concerned with functional improvement after injury, illness, or congenital disorders.
- Psychiatry is the branch of medicine concerned with the bio-psycho-social study of the etiology, diagnosis, treatment and prevention of cognitive, perceptual, emotional and behavioral disorders.

All India Test Series: No student's NEET preparation can be considered complete without a good test series. This test series consists of 6 part tests and 6 full tests on the latest NEET pattern.



COURSE DESCRIPTION

For XII Cum Medical Course only

- This is an integrated course in which students are taught in a systematic way, based on the pattern of NEET along with Board examination.
- The entire course of class XII will be completed by the last week of October, 2021. Exhaustive revision for class XI will take place from the first week of November, 2021 up to the last week of December, 2021.
- This course is divided into 4 units which includes of classroom interaction, fortnightly tests, feedback for each test through micro-level analysis, complete study material of class XI and class XII and review classes on important topics that are conducted after completion of the syllabus.
- Each unit is followed by a unit test and in between each unit test, regular tests on covered topics are taken to evaluate the performance of the students and also to expose them to a competitive environment. This course also covers the syllabus of class XII and eliminates the need for additional tuition. All topics are covered from the basics to indepth level. 


