



## CBSE-TERI GREEN Olympiad

The GREEN Olympiad is an annual written examination on environment conducted by The Energy and Resource Institute (TERI). This examination attracts participation from school students across India and abroad.

## Computing & Informatics Olympiad

It is conducted by IARCS. The main objective of the Indian Computing Olympiad competition is to identify Indian school students with outstanding skills in computer programming and algorithm.

## World Robotics Olympiad

This is the top largest robotic competitions in the world for 9 to 25 year old students who are studying in the field of science & technology.

## Finance Olympiad

National Finance Olympiad (NFO) is organized by International Institute of Financial Market and sponsored by Economic Times. The Olympiad aims to make young students familiar with money management art.

### KVPY

Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana is a scholarship program funded by the Department of Science and Technology of the Government of India, aimed at encouraging students to take up research careers in the areas of basic sciences, engineering and medicine.

### NTSE

National Talent Search Examination is a national-level scholarship program in India to identify and recognize students with high intellect and academic talent. It is one of the most prestigious exams in India.



**Dr. Homi Jehangir Bhabha**

**The Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE)** is the nodal centre of the country for Olympiad programmes in Mathematics, Sciences and Astronomy. The Programmes aim at promoting excellence in science and mathematics among pre-university students.

The programme is financially supported by Government of India, in particular, by Board of Nuclear Sciences (Department of Atomic Energy), Department of Science and Technology, Department of Space and Ministry of Human Resource Development.

### **Mathematical Olympiad Program in India**

The Mathematical Olympiad Programme in India, which leads to participation of Indian students in the International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO), is organized by the Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE) in collaboration with the National Board for Higher Mathematics (NBHM) of the Department of Atomic Energy (DAE), Government of India only. The 1st stage is conducted by Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT), Mathematics Teachers Association (MTA).

The Mathematical Olympiad Programme consists of Six stages, are as follows:

**Stage 1:** Pre-Regional Mathematical Olympiad (PRMO)

**Stage 2:** Regional Mathematical Olympiad (RMO)

**Stage 3:** Indian National Mathematical Olympiad (INMO)

**Stage 4:** International Mathematical Olympiad Training Camp (IMOTC)

**Stage 5:** Pre-departure Training Camp for IMO

**Stage 6:** International Mathematical Olympiad (IMO)

### **Science and Astronomy Olympiad Programs in India**

HBCSE, which is the nodal agency for the Science Olympiad program in the country, conducts the program in close collaboration with Indian Association of Physics Teachers (IAPT), Association of Chemistry Teachers (ACT), and the Association of Teachers in Biological Sciences (ATBS). The first stage of the Olympiad examinations is conducted by IAPT, while the later stages are the responsibility of HBCSE.

## The Science Olympiad programme also follows 5 stages:

### Stage I: National Standard Examinations (NSE)\*

This stage is conducted by IAPT and organized in the Subjects of Physics (NSEP); Chemistry (NSEC); Biology (NSEB); Astronomy (NSEA); Junior Science (NSEJS).

### Stage II: Indian National Olympiad (INO)

This Stage is conducted by The Homi Bhabha Centre for Science Education (HBCSE) and Organized in the Subjects of Astronomy, Biology, Chemistry, Physics (INAO, INBO, INChO, INPO).

### Stage III: Orientation cum Selection Camps (OCSC)

Selection based on performance in INOs for a particular subject.

### Stage IV: Training of Indian Teams for International Olympiads at HBCSE

Selected teams undergo a rigorous training program at HBCSE in theory and experiments.

### Stage V: Participation in International Olympiad (IO)

The selected students from each subject are teamed together with 2-3 Teacher Leaders to accompany them for the International Olympiads.

## Other Olympiads

Other recognized International Olympiads than are not directly organized by HBCSE are

**1. Asian Physics Olympiad (APhO):** Participation is organized by IAPT.

**2. International Astronomy Olympiad - Junior (IAO - Junior):** Participation is organized by the National Council of Science Museums (NCSM).



# THE STEPS TO SUCCESS.

The world of many opportunities starts at Narayana. Young talent is nourished and nurtured right from the primary stage. With ever-evolving technology, the way education is imparted has also considerably evolved. The foundation for a successful career after Grade XII is carefully laid right from Grade VI, giving the students all the right ingredients for a bright career through the IIT Olympiad Program.

IIT-Olympiad Training program will be conducted in four stages.

## STEP 1

A micro-level planning for teaching a particular topic is done by identifying the basics and fundamentals of the topic. The concepts and learning objectives to be mastered and achieved are then charted out along with the linked sub-topics and their technological enrichment.

## STEP 2

The teaching of the prerequisites, main concepts and the linked sub-topics are done from the prescribed text books and study materials with more illustrations and examples using our e-learning modules.

## STEP 3

The objective of mastering the concepts is achieved by making the students to solve problems on each concept from level-1 to level-5 which include the questions from previous competitive exams and various other International reference books.

## STEP 4

At the end of the topic, students are made to solve the cumulative assignments which consists of problems based on multiple concepts to test their understanding of the concept.

**Sub groups:** In every class, the students are divided into five sub groups namely E1, E2, E3, E4 and E5 based on their performance in the series of tests conducted on fundamentals in the beginning of academic year. Each sub group is headed by the respective subject associate faculty who will microscopically cater to the academic needs of the students by following the step up and step down approach.
